

## Question Prompts

When a child cannot answer a question, progress through the following prompts until they can answer the question. Over time you will be able to reduce the level of prompting.

### Hardest prompts

1. Repeat the question, emphasising the key words
2. Give a semantic (meaning) clue, e.g. 'it's a type of fruit'
3. Give a phonemic (sound) clue, e.g. 'a,a,a'
4. Mime/gesture the answer
5. Give two options
6. Model the answer
